


SELF-PROTECTION PLAN, INSTRUCTIONS AND EMERGENCY PLAN.

- If you discover a fire or detect smoke, report it immediately to reception.
- Refrain from opening a door through which smoke is coming out, as this could start a fire.
- Do not lose your calm, do not shout, do not run. You may cause mass hysteria.
- If you find yourself in heavy smoke, put a handkerchief between your hand and mouth and crawl.
- Do not risk your safety and that of others by picking up and carrying objects, you may cause traffic jams.
- In case of evacuation, do not use the car.
- Leave your bungalow by closing doors and windows. This will prevent the fire from spreading.
- Follow the instructions given to you by the members of the Alarm and Evacuation Teams and go to the meeting point indicated to you.
- Do not go back to pick up forgotten objects, you will hinder the evacuation of people and the fight against the fire, endangering your life.
- Do not smoke in bed, it may cause a fire.
- Guests with any physical disability should inform reception so that special attention can be given to them by the helpers.
- Please inform reception if you leave children in the bungalow.



REGULATION

All campers must apply for a pitch at the reception office, collect their stay card and vehicle access card.

The campsite management will require all campers and visitors to show their identity card or passport.

Check-out time will be at 12:00 PM and check-in time will be at 13:00 PM.

Campers and visitors to the campsite are obliged to:

Comply with the rules contained in this brochure, the Internal Regulations and those provisions issued by competent bodies or entities in the field of camping.

Do not exceed the speed limit of 10km/h. Circulation is limited to the entry and exit of customers. Sporting or recreational use will be avoided, especially with regard to bicycles, motorbikes or any other vehicle whose use is restricted on urban roads. In any case, vehicles that exceed the noise level permitted by local by-laws will not be allowed to circulate.

Occupy the plot that has been assigned to them when making the entry and that is shown in the "fichcha de estancia", respecting the limits of the same. The pitch must be occupied by a tent, caravan, etc... if this rule is not complied with, it may be considered as free.

If you are absent from the campsite but continue to occupy the pitch, the amount will continue to be invoiced according to the number of people who normally occupy it.

For billing purposes, any variation in the number of people must be communicated beforehand. Otherwise, the rate to be applied will be according to the number of people registered at reception. Always close the beach door.

Respect the facilities and vegetation of the campsite Leave the taps well closed after use.

Before leaving the campsite or when required by the campsite management, the amount of your stay must be paid, which will be at least one day's stay.

It is forbidden:

Occupying a plot other than the one assigned without the express authorisation of reception.

Lighting fires or using pyrotechnics.

Introducing firearms or any object likely to cause accidents.

Street selling, without exception of any product.

Parking the vehicle in the streets or in places that impede the passage of other vehicles or people. The campsite management accepts no responsibility for any accident caused by improper parking and it will be the sole responsibility of the owner if, due to improper parking, the vehicle impedes the passage of public service vehicles: ambulance, fire brigade, etc...

Using radio or television receivers or any other device with high volume.

Playing sports or games that may disturb or cause accidents to other campers.

Leaving waste, however small, outside the rubbish containers.

Sticking sharp objects into plants or hanging clothes on plants unless it is done in a discreet manner.

Using the sinks for purposes other than washing clothes and kitchen utensils, respectively.

Dumping waste in the plot's water intake drains.

In the children's playground area, children must be accompanied by an adult, who will be fully responsible for any accidents that may occur due to negligence or neglect.

Bathing in the swimming pool after the closing time established in the timetable. During these hours, purification and chlorination treatments are carried out.

Any manipulation of the electrical installation by campers or making inappropriate connections or connections that do not have an earth connection. The campsite management declines any responsibility in the event of an accident.

The entry or keeping of dogs or other loose animals is forbidden. The owner of an animal will be responsible for any damage or nuisance caused, without prejudice to the subsidiary responsibility of the owner.

Animals may not enter those areas or rooms where this prohibition is indicated, especially in Reception.

During the rest period, which shall comprise between 00.00 hours and 07.00 hours the following day:

Absolute silence will be maintained.

No vehicle may enter, leave or circulate around the campsite and must remain parked on the pitch or in the designated areas unless authorised or in an emergency.

The entrance and exit barriers remain closed. Customers wishing to leave or enter the campsite with their vehicle during the above-mentioned hours must park it in the car park at the entrance, which is open 24 hours a day.

VISITORS

People from outside the campsite who intend to visit friends or relatives camping there, must leave their vehicles in the entrance car park and carry out the corresponding registration procedure at reception. If the time of stay is longer than one hour, the visitor will pay the amount corresponding to the visitor's rate.

Visiting hours in any case will be from 8:00 am to 11:00 pm. It is strictly forbidden to access other camping areas other than those of the visiting customer.

By the mere fact of accessing the campsite, you accept to know and agree to the present Internal Regulations and to the other rules and regulations of the campsite that are publicly displayed.

Failure to comply with these Regulations may result in the expulsion of the camper from Camping Mar Menor.

The Management of the campsite is exempt from liability for damage caused by fire, theft or any other cause to the property or the integrity of the campers. The campsite is only liable for the loss of objects or cash that has been deposited in the safety deposit boxes provided for this purpose.
